I tapped on the solenoid mounted on the hydraulic pump and Helen fiddled with the "In" switch and we finally got the bedroom in. It seemed the most

likely candidate for problems as there was the correct voltage both at the switch and at the solenoid. We subsequently took the rig to Amack's RV in Woodland where they confirmed that the solenoid had failed and quickly fixed it. Our repair guy said it was not uncommon for solenoids to fail. Add another spare part to your tool kit. This was the second time I have used Amack's. The first time, after a catastrophic failure on our Sonora trip, he had to replace the hydraulic brake unit with one from Dexter. The latter unit has operated perfectly ever since. I cannot speak too highly of the work done by Amack. The work is done quickly, correctly and at a reasonable price. If you are from up this way, consider using them when you need help. I understand, incidentally, that at one time they were a dealer for Automate. That's an interesting piece of history.

A tip of the hat, by the way, to Matt Matthews of our club who has located a source of repair parts for the original factory hydraulic brake units. In another section of this newsletter, he should have a brief article on how to get the repair kit.

I believe it has been a quiet summer for the club. Our Secretary/ Newsletter editor and Treasurer had several tasks to complete but beyond that it has been quiet. No news is good news as they say. Helen and I will not be in Sonora as we are taking an extended trip which will include the Albuquerque balloon festival, something we have wanted to do for several years. But we will be back in the Spring, looking forward to our annual business meeting. See you then!
